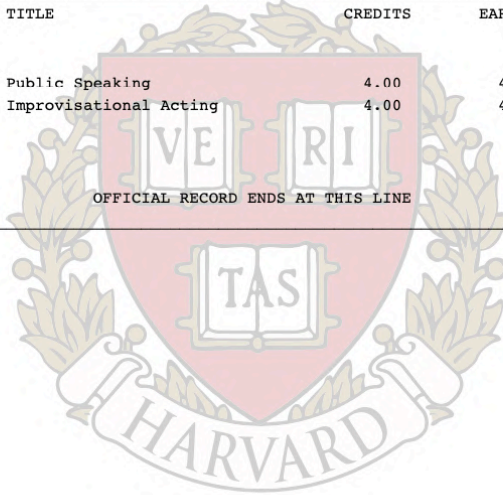

About Me Summary:

I was born in 1997 and raised in Mansfield, Victoria. I played tennis and golf as a child and started dancing at the age of ten after discovering the music and magic of Michael Jackson. This inspired me to busk at the local bush markets for over a decade, raising thousands of dollars for a variety of charities including The Cancer Council, Mansfield Hospital, local schools, and helping local people in need of financial assistance.

Since then, I have been involved in the FReeZA Committee volunteering to organise events for the youth such as music events, local skateboarding competitions and film and photography workshops. I have been an active member of the Mansfield Musical & Dramatic Society which included being involved in the committee, working the sound and light, front of house and productions such as Grease, Footloose, Seussical & The Castle in acting, dancing and sound and light. I have also been involved in Radio Mansfield as a local Mansfield presenter and have assisted as a debutante ball dance teacher for ten events, as well as helping to organise the Victorian Drama Leagues Mansfield Summer Drama Camp, and volunteering at the local high and primary schools.

I was invited to perform for the Jackson Family and have been awarded the top male dancer and model in the World multiple times at the World Championships of Performing Arts hosted in California. I finished VCE drama in the top five percent of Victoria and performed at the Melbourne Arts Centre Top Class with my original piece 'The Cyclist.' In 2015, I won the Fast Track National Talent Showcase, was honoured to be the Georgy Awards Young Emerging Artist, as well as the Mansfield Young Citizen of the Year in 2016.

After completing high school, I trained at Millennium Dance Complex in LA for two months and then undertook three years of full-time study and training in performing arts, dance teaching and management at Transit Dance in Melbourne where I was awarded Student of the Year at graduation. I continue to be involved in local community through radio, theatre, busking, dance teaching, tennis coaching, volunteering, a leader on the Southern Cross Kids Camp for young children with a challenged background and support work for children with special needs. Another career highlight was completing my Silver Duke of Edinburgh Award. I currently teach dance with the Mandala Project, work in hospitality, support work, DJing as well as tennis coaching and busking with my company Urban Class Dance. At Harvard University, I performed a solo dance to Smooth Criminal in the Sanders Theatre receiving a standing ovation from the crowd of hundreds. JFK, Teddy Roosevelt & Oprah Winfrey have all spoken on the Sanders Theatre

I undertook Public Speaking & Improvisational Acting at Harvard Summer School in 2024 receiving straight As in both courses. I run the company Urban Class Dance offering dance teaching, MCing and DJing among other areas.

Liam's summer at Harvard

TEN months ago, I sat in Harvard Yard in Cambridge Massachusetts and began dreaming, planning, preparing for and saving up for this seven-week Harvard Summer Program in Public Speaking and Improvisational Acting, finishing the course with straight As and a letter of recommendation from my acting professor.

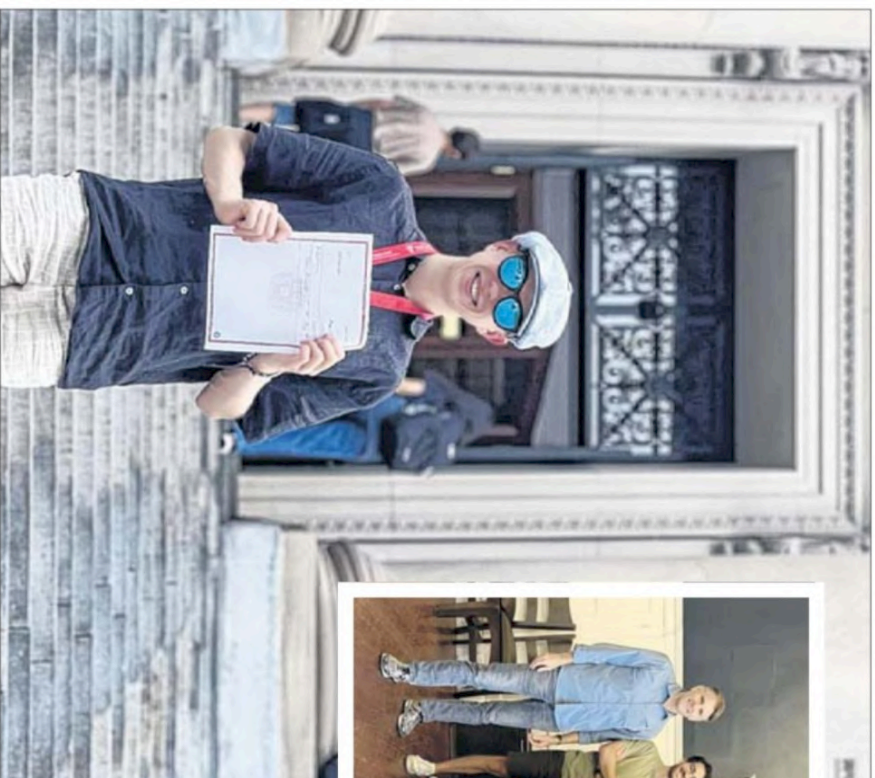
Every week we were tasked with a variety of assignments to present in the four half-day classes a week.

It was an honour to study in the same rooms that the famous Hasty Pudding Club met in.

The Hasty Pudding Club is the oldest social club in the United States (1770) with past members such as John Quincy Adams, Franklin D. Roosevelt, John F. Kennedy, Elizabeth Taylor, John Travolta and Tom Cruise.

It was an amazing opportunity to study and immerse myself in the United States college experience, especially the Annenberg Dining Hall, which looked straight out of Hogwarts and modelled on the Oxford University Dining Hall.

I lived in Randolph Hall (Adams House) in an apartment with five other students who were studying in macroeconomics, math-

ematics and accounting. Other friends studied everything from leadership to astrophysics.

I had my own suite, but we shared a common room which hosted study sessions, film and games night as well as small house parties.

John F. Kennedy worked on his best-selling thesis

'Why England Slept' with his professor in the Coolidge Room directly below our apartment.

Robert Frost, Teddy Roosevelt and J. Robert Oppenheimer were also residents of Randolph Hall.

It is a beautiful house with a music room, art room, fitness centre, social room and

a stunning courtyard.

I loved exploring the Widener Library, the largest private library in the world, built in honour of Harvard Graduate Harry Elkins Widener who perished on the

Titanic (aged twenty-seven), and who found his love of books while a member of

the aforementioned Hasty Pudding Club.

The Harvard Law School, Business School, Design School, Kennedy School of Government and Divinity School were incredible to explore as well.

We also had the opportunity to attend a variety of excursions such as day trips to

Martha's Vineyard and Yale University, a Red Sox Baseball Game at Fenway Park, hiking at Blue Hills, playing a lot of tennis, frisbee and football (and even some golf) as well as attending the various Harvard Museums such as the Art Museum with works from Monet, Van Gough, Pollock and Degas.

Other highlights included training in the Harvard Football Stadium, challenging my suitemate to a running race into Boston one night (3.7 miles/6kms in 25 mins), studying while overlooking the city of Boston city in the Smith Centre, using the various gymnasiums with dance studios and basketball courts as well as performing and receiving a standing ovation to Smooth Criminal in the stunning and famous Sanders Theatre to an audience of around six hundred.

I was even able to sneak in a little busking in Harvard Yard. I have refined my website, LinkedIn and email signature so I am ready to rock and roll upon returning with my company Urban Class Dance, MC-ing, DJing and working with The Mandala Project.

I will never forget my time at Harvard and I look forward to applying the skills and knowledge to the Mansfield community and to my company Urban Class Dance.
